MORE INFORMATION ABOUT THE THEATRE

Transportation/Carpool/Parking:

Make sure Big Buddy knows if and when you are using the buses.

For drop off Friday, Pick up Friday, Drop off Saturday:
carpool spot is almost directly across the street from the Old State Capitol on North Blvd near River Road. All children not riding busses will be picked up in the lobby of the theatre approximately five minutes after the performance.

PARKING for the Performance:

You should arrive early and expect to take fifteen minutes to park. There is a paid parking lot on Convention between 3rd and Lafayette.

What to bring to the Theatre:

The dancers will be backstage and sitting for a good while Friday and Saturday. Here are some things they might want to bring to the theatre: A Blanket or soft jacket, water bottle, red lipstick and hair "refreshers" (a brush or hairspray for example) Dancers may additionally bring phones/games for entertainment... they will be backstage for a good while. If you send electronic devices, please label them and send ear buds/head phones. Dancers should bring a bag or purse to put their devices in while they are performing.

Hair & Makeup

Hair should be SLICKED back and secured in a low bun or off the forehead. NO BANGS and NO "fly-a-ways". Please make sure pins are secured and hair is "head-shakable" (have your child shake their head as fast as they can to test). Makeup can be as simple or as fancy as you desire, but all girls must wear red lipstick and a little blush so they will not be washed out by the lights. Two examples of 24 hour lipstick are Covergirl Outlast All-Day (my favorite) & Revlon Colorstay Overtime.

Videos & Photos

We are so thankful for Eye Wander Photo and the Lipsey Foundation for helping families get free pictures and a video of the show. As per our contract with the Manship Theatre, you *MAY NOT* take pictures or video in their theatre. PLEASE help us out with this... and *DO NOT* take pictures or video. Again, the show will be filmed and photographed, and your dancer will receive an individual picture, a cast picture, and a video. The will be available a few months after the performance.
